The speakers will cover a broad range of Child Neurology topics which will include advancements in diagnosis and treatments in Epilepsy, Movement disorders, Traumatic brain injury /Concussion, Neuromuscular diseases, Neurodevelopmental disabilities and Auto-immune Neurologic diseases among others.

Purpose and Content The aim of this symposium is to impact positive changes in physician competency, improve performance in clinical Pediatric Neurology practice and subsequently improve patient outcomes. 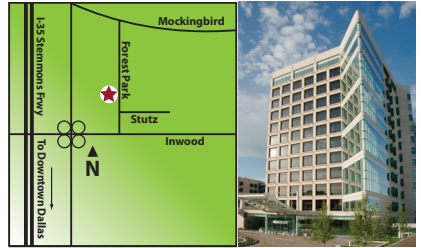
