Target Audience

Primary care providers, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and specialists in Internal Medicine and Family Practice seeking updates in practical knowledge relating to patient care.

Purpose and Content

The Update in Internal Medicine is a program emphasizing topics requested by our referring physicians, controversies arising from journal clubs, and posed by our trainees. The program highlights diagnostic and therapeutic solutions based on the most recent clinical science. The goal of the program is to provide state-of-the-art practical advice on issues identified as frequent items for consultation and second opinions, as well as new advances in applying molecular techniques in translational medicine.

Educational Objectives

Upon completion of this activity, participants should be able to link the educational objectives to Core Competencies (Medical Knowledge) and:

- Develop new protocols for evaluating chest pain in patients where a myocardial infarction is of concern
- Utilize a sequential approach to management of CHF
- Formulate appropriate therapy course with proton pump inhibitors

- Utilize a comprehensive therapeutic approach for patients with diabetes to reduce renal, cardiac, and ocular morbidity from the disease

UT Southwestern Medical Center Office of CME has transitioned to a new online registration system.

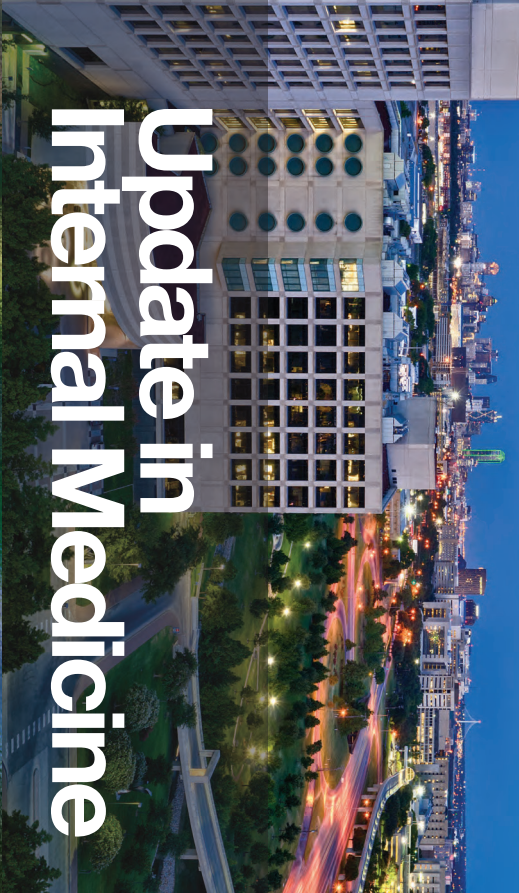
After opening the registration link, you will be prompted to login to an account within the online system in order to register. If you have not previously registered for any courses you must first create a user profile and then can go back and register for the course.
