Pancreatic Cancer Symposium 2026 (RP2604C) will be held on **Saturday, April 18, 2026**. This continuing education activity will take place live in-person at the **UT Southwestern Medical Center's T. 3. Discuss the role of different chemotherapy and radiation therapy modalities for pancreatic cancer.
4. Compare and contrast the potential benefits of minimally invasive surgery in pancreatic cancer.
5. Discuss nutritional options for managing exocrine insufficiency.
