

Dear Representative,

The **46th Annual Resident and Alumni Day (RP2606B)** will be held on **Saturday, June 13, 2026**. This continuing education activity will take place live in-person at the UT Southwestern Medical Center T. Boone Pickens Biomedical Building in Dallas, TX and is sponsored by UT Southwestern Internal Medicine Department, and the Office of Continuing Education at UT Southwestern Medical Center.

46th Annual Resident and Alumni Day (**RP2606B**) provides practicing ophthalmologists with updates on diagnostics, therapeutics, and surgical advancements. Through didactic lectures, an ethics presentation, and interactive Q&A sessions, attendees will assess new treatments, analyze disparities in care, review complex cases, and explore the ethical implications of ophthalmic practice. Addressing key gaps in knowledge, competence, and performance, this course enhances clinical decision-making and patient outcomes.

This course is designed for providers in the specialty of Ophthalmology.

Learning Objectives include:

1. Analyze real-world outcomes data for newer anti-VEGF therapies in AMD and DME to optimize treatment selection.
2. Evaluate combination therapy (PRP plus anti-VEGF) versus monotherapy in proliferative diabetic retinopathy.
3. Identify prognostic factors and surgical timing for neo-vascular glaucoma and post-open globe retinal detachments.
4. Compare clinical outcomes and surgical efficiency between preloaded DSAEK and traditional insertion techniques.
5. Demonstrate utility of 3D heads-up visualization systems in endothelial keratoplasty procedures.
6. Describe the role of LRRC15 in corneal stromal fibrosis as a potential therapeutic target.
7. Evaluate surgical techniques for congenital ptosis repair and the role of tarsectomy.
8. Assess diagnostic utility of doppler ultrasound in giant cell arteritis.
9. Analyze CSS titration techniques for eyelid symmetry and innovative dacryolithiasis management.
10. Identify ocular manifestations of Reactive Infectious Mucocutaneous Eruption (RIME).
11. Evaluate sustained-release drug delivery systems for glaucoma management.
12. Analyze outcomes of combined anterior-posterior segment surgical approaches.
