The **2026 Year in Oncology Review (RP2611B)** will be held on **Saturday, November 14, 2026**. This continuing education activity will take place live and in-person at the **UT Southwestern Medical Center's T. Boone Biomedical Building (NG3.112)** in **Dallas, TX** and is sponsored by the **UT Southwestern Department of Internal Medicine-Hematology/Oncology Division**, and the Office of Continuing Education at UT Southwestern Medical Center.
